Purpose: Encourage excellent young people actively participate in social welfare activities, the establishment of community leadership. Help young generations becoming respected leaders in the community to make positive impact to people's lives and our environment by creating collaboration from good health, love and wisdom.

1. Eligibility:

- Student age from 15 – 20 years old
- Self introduction essay
- Academic GPA 3.75 or above (school transcript required)
- STC Foundation member (please see membership application)
- Participating in community activities (STC Foundation events or approved events) with total cumulative 200 point

2. Procedures:

- Submit completed document with scholarship application to Scholarship Committee
- Documents shall be reviewed by community leaders or officials at committee's discretion.
- The qualified finalists shall be notified for interviews by the Committee

3. Applications Due Date: June of each year

4. Scholarship Receivers:

- A total of 10 receivers (\$500.00 per person)
- Award by government officials or the community leaders with certificates
- Award by STC Foundation with certificate

5. Participation Score:

- 10 points for each participated social/community event upon approval
- Points for participating in the youth leadership training camp as:
 - Student: 25 points
 - Full-time counselors: 30 points
 - Part-time counselors: 15 points
